2022 was a year of increased kidnappings, gang violence, gas shortages, a Cholera outbreak, and an almost nonfunctioning government that made it very dangerous to travel from place to place; but God has a plan and He is not done with Haiti! Rejoice with us about all that has been done in 2022 through the ministry of Lift Kids Haiti by God's grace!!

- 61 people were born again and 25 were baptized.
- 27 kids that live far from our schools were sponsored.
- 100 students in both the Tent City school and the La Tramblay Village school attended school this year.
- 1000's of meals cooked & served at the kid's churches.
- We distributed 100s of bags of rice, beans, and oil for people that were displaced by the gangs.
- We gave out 180 audio Bibles to those that cannot read.
- We distributed water filter straws & Aquatabs for clean water.
- 12 Orphans were fed, educated, and provided for so they can stay in their safe and loving home.
- We began constructing a safety wall around the Mango Tree Church property.

The churches held weekly kid's churches and nights of fasting and prayer. They also held women's and youth meetings, evangelism classes, a crusade, and Christmas parties for the orphans and kids' church kids.

Marriages were restored, demons were cast out, and people were healed of sicknesses. The most recent healing was a man that was in great pain and almost lost his foot to diabetes. He has been completely healed and he walks to church pain free. The Lord is good!!

We want to say thank you to everyone who supported Lift Kids Haiti in 2022 especially One Plus God Ministries for all the help in feeding the kids and the displaced people.

It is a crazy late start because of all the gang violence and gas shortages but most of our students are back and they are so thankful! We are still enrolling some students, but we plan to have 100 students at both schools. Our teachers are so happy to be back in the classroom loving on the students and teaching them. We thank God that there is now gas in the country and the gangs are calming down, thus making it safer to go out and about. Thank you all for praying for Haiti. We have been praying for this for months. The school will still be able to get a full year of school in because we will not take a normal break for summer.

We are looking forward to what else the Lord will do in the lives of the Haitian people this year and how Lift Kids Haiti can be a part of the work He is doing.
